Dear Taxpayer,

Prior to this year, taxpayers who had a tax liability of \$25,000.00 or more per installment were required to submit their tax payments via electronic means. As such, payment stubs were omitted from the tax bill.

This year, our office decided to forgo this requirement. However, when the tax bills for this year were mailed out, taxpayers previously subject to this requirement received a bill without payment stubs. At this time, there is no requirement in place for assessments over \$25,000.00 per installment.

Should you elect to make your payment via check, please make the check payable to: Riverside County Treasurer. Payments can still be made via electronic means – either on our website via electronic check or credit card. Please note, there is no fee for payments made via electronic check; Payments made via credit card will have a 2.28% convenience fee while debit card payments have a flat fee of \$3.95.

Payments can also be made via wire payment. Should you choose this method, please email us at ttewirepayments@rivco.org for wiring instructions.

We are enclosing a copy of your tax bill with the payment stubs attached. Payments must be postmarked by the United States Post Office by their statutory due dates in order to be considered a timely payment.
